Day 1 – Monday, September 7, 2026

DEPART USA

We depart San Francisco/SFO today, on British Airlines flight # BA284 to London at 4:35pm.

Day 2 – Tuesday, September 8, 2026

ARRIVE LISBON / FATIMA

Arrive London at 11:00am. Connect on flight # BA506 departing for Lisbon at 3:05pm. Arrive Lisbon at 5:55pm. After checking through immigration and customs, meet our guide and driver for the ride to Fatima. Time permitting, we enjoy an afternoon Mass and an orientation walk in the Fatima Sanctuary, including the Chapel of Apparitions and Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary. We continue to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 – Wednesday, September 9, 2026

FATIMA

In the morning, we celebrate Mass, then visit the Chapel of the Apparitions, the Basilica, the tombs of Francisco, Jacinta and Sr. Lucia, and the Monument to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In Ajustrel and Valinhos, we see the two homes of the little shepherds, and the site of the first and third visit of the "Angel of Peace". Lastly, we stop at the Parish Church and the cemetery where Francisco and Jacinta were once buried. The balance of the day is at leisure. After dinner at the hotel, we may join a nightly candlelight procession.

Day 4 – Thursday, September 10, 2026

FATIMA / BURGOS

After breakfast, we celebrate morning Mass at Santarem, then proceed to Burgos. Time permitting, we may stop in Loyola to visit the Shrine of St. Ignacio of Loyola. Once in Burgos, we enjoy a guided tour of the UNESCO listed Cathedral of Burgos. The cathedral is a masterpiece of Spanish Gothic architecture, built from white limestone, and renowned for its elegance. At days end, we proceed to the hotel to enjoy dinner and overnight.

Day 5 – Friday, September 11, 2026

BURGOS / LOURDES

After breakfast, checkout, and morning Mass, we board our coach for the ride to Lourdes. In Lourdes, we check in to the hotel enjoy dinner and free time in the evening for those who wants to participate in candlelight procession. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 6 – Saturday, September 12, 2026

LOURDES

After breakfast and morning Mass, we visit the historical and spiritual sites associated with the visionary child Bernadette. We see Boly Mill where St. Bernadette was born, and the "Cachot," an abandoned prison where Bernadette's impoverished family lived. We attend the Blessing of the Sick, and drink the water from the miraculous spring and/or have the opportunity to submerge ourselves in the healing baths. We follow this with a walking tour that includes the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, the Miraculous Spring, the Shrine of Bernadette, and the XII century Castle. We tour the Basilica of St. Pius X, the world's largest underground church. The evening is free for an optional Blessed Sacrament Procession, before dinner. After dinner we may participate in a candlelight procession before retiring for the evening.

Day 7 – Sunday, September 13, 2026

LOURDES / TOULOUSE / MONTPELIER

After breakfast and check-out, we depart to Toulouse. This southern French city was once a Roman colony and is home to numerous religious and historical treasures. Here we view many of these rare artifacts, such as twenty historical pipe organs and the burial place of St. Thomas Aquinas at the St. Semin Basilica. Following our visit to this magnificent church, we continue to Montpellier, where we have a brief orientation tour of the historic city center, celebrate Mass, then dinner and overnight.

Day 8 – Monday, September 14, 2026

MONTPELIER / LA SALETTE

After breakfast and check-out, we depart for La Salette. We celebrate an afternoon Mass, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure at this serene mountain sanctuary, followed by dinner and overnight.



Day 9 – Tuesday, September 15, 2026

LA SALETTE

After breakfast morning Mass where we will have renewal of vows, we then visit the beautiful town and mountain scenery of La Salette, the second most important pilgrimage destination in France. On 19 September 1846, on the site of Notre-Dame-de-la-Salette, an apparition of the Virgin Mary is said to have appeared in tears to two children of local shepherds and spoken to them at length. Return to the hotel for overnight.

Day 10 – Wednesday, September 16, 2026

LA SALETTE / LYON / ARS

After breakfast, we check out and drive to Lyon. We enjoy a Panoramic city tour, including the Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière and the Old Town. We continue our drive to the hotel in Ars, for an afternoon Mass, then dinner and overnight.

Day 11 – Thursday, September 17, 2026

ARS / NEVERS

Today, we explore Ars, famous though the holy life and labors of St. John Vianney, its beloved Cure. The story of the John Vianney emphasizes how God uses the simple and under-rated people to confound those who are regarded as wise by the world – a man who was considered only marginally fit to be a priest and became a saint. Continue our drive to Nevers for afternoon Mass, dinner and overnight.

Day 12 – Friday, September 18, 2026

NEVERS / LISIEUX

We start our day with a visit to the shrine of Saint-Bernadette, where we can see her incorrupt body, and the convent where she came to live at the age of 22, until she died. A short distance from the chapel and the shrine of Bernadette, is a replica of the grotto of Masabielle. We pause for a noon-time Mass, followed by free time, before going to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 13 Saturday, September 19, 2026

LISIEUX / MONT SAINT MICHEL / LISIEUX

After breakfast, we head to Mont St. Michel and visit the Monastery of Le Mont St. Michel, also known as “The Wonder of the Western World”. The monastery is surrounded by a magnificent bay, which has one of the greatest tidal ranges in Europe, resulting in a breathtaking view. In 709, Michael the Archangel, requested that Aubert, Bishop of Avranches, build and consecrate this monastery. Since the 9th century, the Abbey has been home to a monastic community to ensure the

continuation of a spiritual presence. For centuries, it has been a pilgrimage site for those seeking Eternal Life with God. We enjoy an afternoon Mass before returning to Lisieux for dinner and overnight.

Day 14 – Sunday, September 20, 2026

LISIEUX / PARIS

After breakfast, we explore the life of St. Therese. According to Pope Pius X, St. Therese of Lisieux was the “greatest saint of modern times”. Her extraordinary love for God and service to humanity comes alive as we walk in the great Saint’s footsteps. We will visit her family home, Les Buissonnets, see the beautiful Basilica of St. Therese and magnificent mosaics and stained glass contained within and have a Mass. Afterwards, we view personal objects of St. Therese. We tour the parish of St. Therese, the Cathedral of St. Peter, and the Carmelite Convent, where she entered in 1888, and is currently entombed with her parents. We then board the bus to transfer to the “City of Lights”, Paris, to enjoy dinner and overnight.

Day 15 – Monday, September 21, 2026

PARIS

We begin our tour of Paris at Our Lady of Miraculous Medal. After celebrating Mass, we view the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Laboure. The Saint’s guardian angel led her to the chapel where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to her. During the apparitions, Our Lady repeatedly instructed the making and purpose of the Miraculous Medal. According to the Blessed Virgin Mary, those who wear the Miraculous Medal receive special protection and abundant graces. Afterwards, we walk to nearby Saint Vincent de Paul Church. We continue our tour of Paris with a stop at Notre Dame Cathedral. The panoramic bus tour then takes us to other recognizable symbols of the city of Paris including the Eiffel Tower, the Invalides, the L’Arc de Triomphe, and the Champ-Elysees, the world’s most famous boulevard. We stop at La Madeleine, with the statue of Mary Magdalene carried to heaven by angels, followed by dinner and overnight.

Day 16 – Tuesday, September 22, 2026

PARIS / DEPART TO USA

We depart Paris today on British Airways flight # BA315 at 8:15am to London. Arrive London at 8:35am. Connect on flight # BA285 for San Francisco at 10:45am. Arrive SFO at 1:50pm.
